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Dear Parents,

This year Manly West Band Camp is being held on **Monday 24 and Tuesday 25 May** at the Sydney Academy of Sport and Recreation, Narrabeen. It has been planned to supplement and extend the work being done in band lessons and it is considered essential for all band members to attend.

The cost of the camp for Intermediate, Concert and Performance Band members is **\$265**. The cost was issued as part of Semester 1's invoice. Full payment must be made in advance of attendance.

The Band camp fee includes:

- eight hours of professional music tuition which includes full band rehearsals and sectional tutorials
- overnight accommodation and food (2 morning teas, lunch, dinner and breakfast)
- bus transport to and from camp and,
- Sports Academy activities on the afternoon of both days

Outdoor activities will include canoeing (Years 5 & 6), ropes courses, rock climbing, flying fox and archery led by the trained staff of the Sydney Sports Academy.

In addition to staff from the Sydney Academy of Sport and Recreation, teachers from Manly West will attend the camp on both days and supervise the students on their overnight stay. All Manly West staff members have CPR and emergency care training.

Activities will also be supported by parent volunteers. Yes, we need your help!

Packing list: (ALL LABELLED PLEASE! DON'T FORGET TO ATTACH YOUR RIBBONS – WHICH WILL BE SUPPLIED - TO YOUR INSTRUMENT, MUSIC STAND, BACK PACK AND OVERNIGHT BAG)

Your instrument, music and stand will travel with you on the bus. Everything else needs to be packed into **ONE** overnight bag.

- ☐ Instrument and accessories (please make sure you have spare reeds, cleaning cloths, cork grease, slide oil etc)
- ☐ Music stand
- ☐ Music folder and two pencils and rubber in a library bag or similar
- ☐ A nut-free snack for the morning of Day One (we have an early start & morning tea is not until 11.30)
- ☐ Drink bottle
- ☐ Lip balm
- ☐ Covered shoes (covered shoes to be worn at all times outside the cabins and for outside activities)
- ☐ Spare enclosed shoes that are suitable to get wet (for canoeing kids – they will step into the water while getting into the canoe)
- ☐ Hat
- ☐ Rain jacket
- ☐ Towel
- ☐ Sleeping bag, single fitted sheet, pillow and pillow case
- ☐ 2 sets of clothing (Years 5 and 6 – extra clothes that can get wet for canoeing)
- ☐ pyjamas
- ☐ toiletries (including sunscreen)
- ☐ plastic bag for wet/dirty clothes
- ☐ Book for quiet reading before lights out (optional), playing cards
- ☐ **Medication, if required, must be labelled with your child's name and given to the teacher prior to the bus journey. Please supply a bum-bag or similar for asthma and/or anaphylactic medications, together with a copy of the current action plan.**
