Boyle Street Gate

We ask that parents assist in keeping the lower Boyle Street gate closed. It is sometimes wedged open causing a safety risk, particularly to parent with toddlers and our younger students.

School Absences

Missing school means your child misses out on vital educational information and maintaining learning routines. This can result in a loss of confidence and missing out on forming vital friendships.

Attendance is recorded each day. As a parent or caregiver you are responsible for ensuring your child attends school every day, including sports days unless your child:

- ☐ has an unavoidable medical or dental appointment (preferably these should be made after school or during holidays)
- ☐ is required to attend a recognised religious holiday
- ☐ is required to attend an exceptional or urgent family circumstance (such as attending a funeral)
- ☐ is sick, or has an infectious illness.

If you are having difficulty getting your child to attend school regularly please talk to your child's teacher. If your child has to be absent from school for any reason, including arriving late or leaving early, please either tell your child's teacher or an administration officer at our school, or explain the reason by using the MWPS app, phone, email, or written note as soon as possible and within seven days.

Ethics

Special Ethics Education (SEE) **may** be an option for students who attend Non-Scripture. This is dependent on available volunteer teachers from our school community. Priority to Ethics is given to students of Ethics volunteers, followed by students who have previously attended Ethics and those students who were on the Ethics waiting list last year. At this stage we are able to offer Ethics to students in Years 2-6. If Ethics becomes available for Year 1 and Kindergarten students, we will send home a note to parents of students attending Non-Scripture.

If you are interested in your child attending Ethics, please consider volunteering to teach Ethics. This year we welcomed new Ethics Coordinator and Manly West parent, Lisa Palmer. Please see the note below about volunteering to be an Ethics teacher.

Student Wellbeing

Responding to teasing or being annoyed is one of the common challenges that children have to face at school. Being bullied is more serious. Bullying is when one child (or a group) repeatedly and deliberately uses negative words and/or hostile actions against one specific child that causes distress. Below are some key messages that we encourage you to speak to your child/children about. These messages form part of the Bounce Back program being taught in Terms 2 and 3 and relate to our school expectations of respect, responsibility and Aspire.

Key Messages to communicate to your child about bullying:

- It's never OK to bully someone or take part in bullying even in small ways.
- It's not OK to say 'someone else started it' or 'someone else made me do it' or 'everyone else was doing it too'. You must take responsibility for your own actions.
- It's never the fault of the person who is being bullied.
- If someone is different or annoying they do not deserve to be bullied. No one does. We all have the right to be ourselves and be safe from being mistreated.
- It is important to 'think for yourself'.
- If other people try to convince you to take part in bullying someone, don't just do what they tell you to do. Think for yourself and do what is right and don't just go along with what other children are doing.
- Asking for support and acting responsibly are not the same as dobbing.
- Dobbing means trying to get someone into trouble. It's not dobbing when you ask for help when you're in trouble or when you try to help someone else who is in trouble.

Make sure your belongings have your name and current class on them.

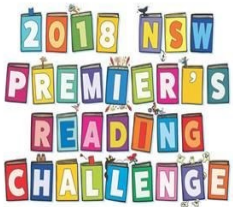
Kitchen Garden

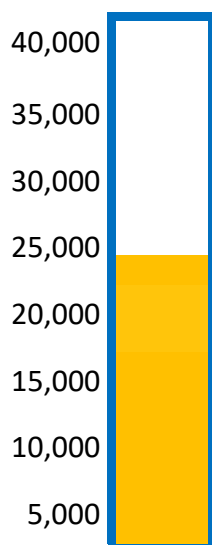

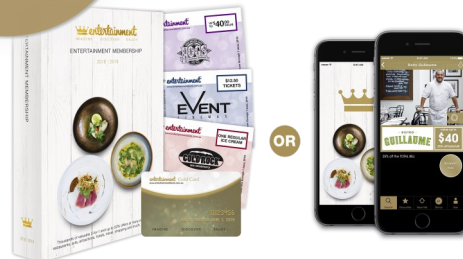

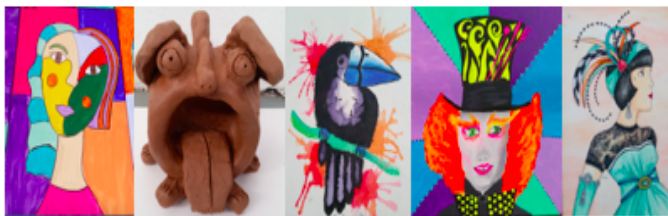
