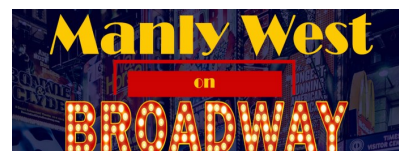

Book Parade – Thursday 8th November

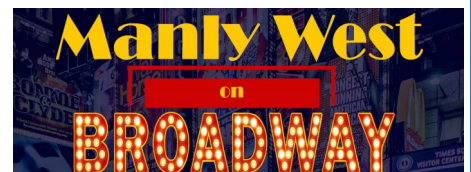

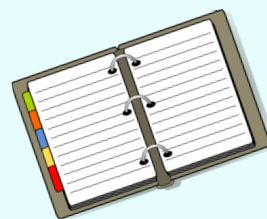

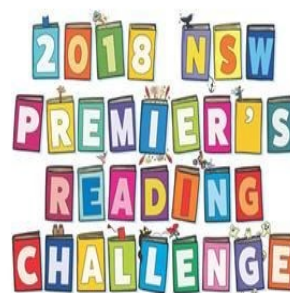


Library News

Band News

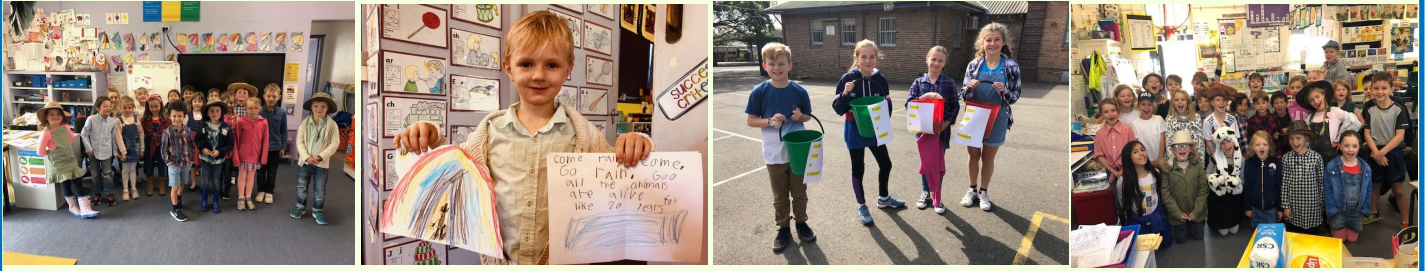
