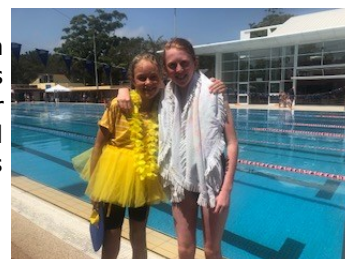


Congratulations! Canteen News

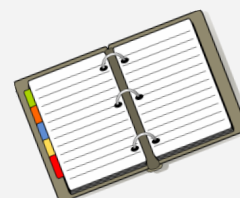

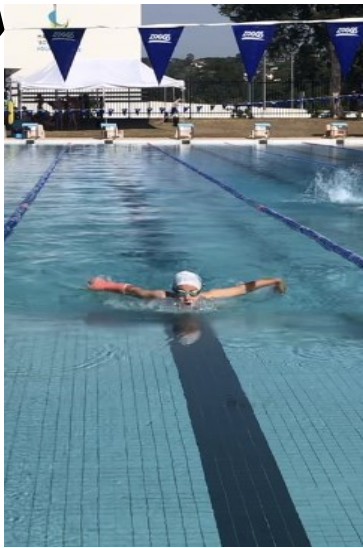

Kitchen Garden News

In the Kitchen Garden this week...

Year 3

This week Year 3 are learning all about compost. What is compost? How to make compost lasagne (layers of 'green' & 'brown' waste), why it's important to turn compost (answer - it's a living system and needs air!). Compost is super easy to make and fantastic for your garden if you're growing edibles or even ornamentals. It feeds the soil and thereby feeds the plants that grow in it. If you want to learn how to do it, ask your Year 3 student (or for that matter, your Year 4, 5 or 6 student, they should be able to tell you as they've all learnt in the Kitchen Garden program!), or sign up to help in the garden and I'll show you how.

ABSENCES

To ensure the safety and welfare of the children in our care, **BASC MUST BE NOTIFIED** if a child will be absent from a booked session. Non Notification delays our awareness of any legitimate concern for a child's safety. Also, whilst looking for children and contacting parents, our Educators are having less time with the children in their care. Email to admin@mwbasccom.au is our preferred communication method. If we do not hear from you regarding an absence by bell time at 3.20pm, a Non-Notification of Absence Charge of \$11 (incl GST) will be added to your account.

WE WOULD PREFER NOTIFICATION OF AN ABSENCE AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE SO WE CAN PROCESS AND ALSO OFFER EMERGENCY CASUAL SPOTS IF NEEDED.

Signing Your Child In or Out of BASC

Just a few points to note on the Government mandated Electronic Sign-In (ESI):

- ⇒ Please **DO NOT mark your child as Absent** on the ESI, please email us instead.
- ⇒ Please remind your children going to External Activities that **they need to come to BASC first** to be signed in and grab some afternoon tea, even if they are have an activity straight after school. This is now necessary under the ESI.
- ⇒ For security reasons, do not share your Pin with others. If someone else is dropping off or collecting your child, make sure they are listed in the Emergency Contacts and Authorisations area of the Manly West BASC HUBWORKS Portal at <https://manlywestbasccom.au> with their mobile number. (This is different from that which was previously advised!) They will then be able to set up their own Pin when they come to sign.
- ⇒ Even if listed, please let us know if the person collecting your child is not a familiar face at BASC. This is especially important if they are signing for the first time and setting up their Pin.



Kiss & Drop Zone



Our Kiss & Drop Zones in Hill Street and Boyle Street are for your convenience and for your child's safety. Designed for quick entry and exit, it minimises congestion and risk when used properly by all parents.

- The Kiss & Drop Zone operates under '**No Parking**' traffic rules.
- Stopping for more than 2 minutes is not allowed in a No Parking area.
- Kiss & Drop Zone cannot be used for parking between
8am-9.30am & 2.30pm-4pm on school days.
- You are obliged to remain in, or within 3 metres of, your vehicle.
- Park safely and legally, even if it means walking further to the school gate. Parking signs are planned with children's safety in mind.
- Penalties for not complying with School Zone parking are levied by Northern Beaches Council and RMS. Rangers are active in the area.
- Demerit points apply to parking infringements in school zones!

For the Safety of Children in the Kiss & Drop Zone - Points to Remember

Drivers Do Not Leave your Vehicle - to assist with traffic flow in the Kiss & Drop Zone, drivers are encouraged to remain in the car while the children get in & out. To facilitate this, children should travel with bags in the car and not in the boot. If a driver must get out, they **MUST NOT** move more than 3 metres from their vehicle.

Be Timely - If your child does not enter or exit the vehicle within 2 minutes you are required to travel around the block and re-enter the zone at the end of the queue.

Kerb Side Entry / Exit - Ensure your child enters / exits the vehicle on the kerb side. Ensure your child has their restraint securely fastened before moving off from the Kiss & Drop Zone.

Stay in Sequence - Please queue in an orderly manner. Drop/pick-up your child as close as you can to the **TOP** of the zone, allowing vehicles following you to enter the designated area.

No U Turns - In busy school zones this is dangerous and puts children at risk.

Drive ways - Don't park over or drop off kids in driveways of neighbouring homes.

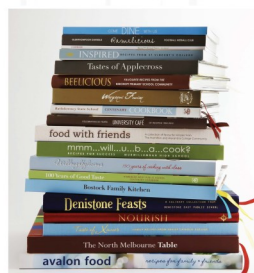
