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Year 2 Australian Museum Excursion

Dear Parents,

On Tuesday 27th June, Year 2 will be visiting the Australian Museum. Students will be exploring a range of educational galleries and exhibits including Surviving Australia, Search and Discover, Wild Planet and Indigenous First Australians Gallery. They will also take part in a one hour educational session called Dinosaurs – **Feathers, Teeth & Claws**. These activities will align with our Term 2 Science unit 'Dinosaurs and More'. The cost of the excursion is **\$32**.

On the day of the excursion, students are required to be at school at **8.30am** for roll call and need to meet their teacher in their classroom. Buses will arrive back at school in time for pick up at 3.20pm. Students are encouraged to bring a **small bag** that will fit their fruit break, recess and lunch, a water bottle, raincoat, hat and jumper. Students may also like to bring a small notepad and pen. No other equipment is required for the day.

Parent helpers: Three parent helpers from each class will be asked to assist on the day. Helpers will travel on the bus with the students in the morning and afternoon. Unfortunately, no siblings are able to attend this excursion with parent helpers. Please tick the relevant box below if you are able to help out.
