Your child is invited to participate in Project Penguin 2023. Project Penguin includes Northern Beaches Secondary College students from Balgowlah Boys, Cromer and Mackellar Girls campuses working with Taronga Zoo and Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 students from local primary schools on a joint project to help conserve the Little Penguin colonies of Sydney Harbour. Students will be involved in an extensive range of learning activities including excursions to Little Manly Beach and Taronga Zoo, which will include field studies and talks from guest speakers.

These excursions drive the learning outcomes of the program as well as develop skills in teamwork, critical thinking, design thinking, cooperation, time management and leadership.
