## Year 2 School Swimming and Water Safety Program

Wednesday 8th September, 2023

Dear Parents.

This year during Week 3 and Week 4 of Term 4, Year Two will be participating in the Department of Education's School Swimming and Water Safety Program. This is a two-week intensive swim program which develops water confidence and provides students with water safety and survival skills.

The program caters for all ability levels whether your child is learning to swim, a non-swimmer or a competent squad swimmer. Lessons are 45 minutes long. Students will be walking to and from the Andrew Boy Charlton Swim Centre each day.

The two-week program will run from Monday 23rd October until Friday 3rd November, 2023.

## Times

2H and 2F- 45 minute session from 9.30 - 10.15am. Students are required to meet in their classroom at the 8.50am bell.

2A and 2B - 45 minute session from 10.15am - 11am. Students are required to be at school by the normal 9.20am bell.

2T - 45 minute session from 11.15am. Students will leave school for the pool at 10.45am.

Students will need to wear their sports uniform and bring or wear the following:

- swimming costume
- goggles
- towel
- swimming cap (optional)
- rash vest or t-shirt
- school hat
- plastic bag for wet items
- water resistant sunscreen
- school jumper for cooler days
- Underwear to get changed into.

All items need to be packed in a small backpack or sports bag. Please ensure all items are clearly labelled with your child's name and class. Due to the increase of physical activity, your child may need extra morning tea or lunch.

## Pool entry cost

Entry to the pool for the two weeks is \$72.00 as there is no cost for the lessons. If your child has a Boy Charlton season pass and you wish to use it, please indicate by ticking yes below. They will need to carry the pass each day to gain entry to the pool.
