Costuming and Final Information Note.

Dear Parents,

It nearly here, an exciting and rewarding experience. There are two types of performances this year. Each group will perform in a live and then a 'recorded' dance. **All children need to attend every 'live' performance** but as a treat, you may wish to purchase a ticket for you and your child, to attend the filmed version.

A few last-minute reminders/information: each performance is for an hour and a quarter.

All dancers are to be delivered to the holding room <u>half an hour prior to their performance</u>, they will be shown where to go when we attend our full-dress rehearsal/filming schedule.

Could you please read through the behavior expectations with your child/ren so that you are both aware of what is acceptable. The publicity note, which is included on the behavior note, will need to be returned prior to the dress rehearsal.

The children will then be available for collection from the holding room after their live performance (a teacher will be present until all children have been collected).

Collection Times:

The 8pm performances can be collected from 9:15pm onwards. To make it easier for parents, at the conclusion of the show we will venture downstairs and stand in a convenient spot for you to collect (we will show the children where), unless you are waiting, to collect your child. Please ensure your child has something warm to put on at the end of the show, as it gets extremely cold once the sun sets.

It is suggested that you carpool where necessary, please ask around.

Reminder: NO LUNCH ORDERS FOR MONDAY 26[™] June or THURSDAY 29[™] June.

Dress Rehearsal/Film Day.

Our dress rehearsal/film day is Monday 26th June. The children will need to wear their school/sport uniform and bring all make-up and hair products. They will be given their costumes after recess on the Monday. All three groups will be departing school before lunch. Therefore, no lunch orders that day. The three groups will then perform and be filmed (in their allocated time slots). Our last group rehearsal concludes 3pm, so it is likely that the bus will be returning to school after the 3:20pm bell. This might affect the junior girls who will then need to return to the theatre at 5:00pm for their live 5:30pm performance. The Senior Girls and the Boys will be fine, as they do not perform until the 8pm show.

All our groups are performing in and watching a matinee on Thursday 29th June. We will be departing school at 9am, all children will need to be in full costume and make-up but also bring/wear, if possible, tracksuit pants/top/jumper (with a Zipper) to keep themselves warm and protect their costumes from food. They all should bring their fruit break, drinks and lunch. If time and weather permits, they may be taken to the Glenrose Shopping Centre to purchase a 'treat.'

HAIR AND MAKEUP: Girls:

Hair is to be a centre part and a low bun.

Make-up: all girls, regardless of complexion will need to wear full stage make-up (foundation, eye liner, mascara, eye shadow, powder/blush and Fire Engine Red lipsick. I have included a picture of a before and after shot, an eye shot that will assist those trying to do full make-up for the first time. Pictures below are for you to use.

Please, no jewellry, watches, bands, bracelets or similar are to be worn on either Monday 26th June or Thursday 29th June.
