Dear Parents,

Our Swimming Carnival will be held on **Tuesday 9th February**, **2021** at Manly Swim Centre from **9:45am – 2:15pm**. Children from Years 3 - 6 will walk to the pool and back with their class teachers straight after a morning assembly. It is important that all children be at school by **8:50am** so that rolls can be checked and we are able to set off straight away. The carnival must start promptly in order to finish by **2:00 pm**.

Year 2 children <u>who turn 8 in 2021</u> and participate in a junior <u>squad swimming program (with times)</u> may attend the carnival. They will be competing against 8 year olds from Year 3 in freestyle events. Year 2 students will require a time for 50 metres freestyle to enter. They will walk down to the pool with a Year 2 teacher and walk back to school once their events have been completed.

The cost of the carnival is **\$8** to cover the hire of the pool and will be included in the Semester 1 Account. Unfortunately, season pass holders will not be able to use their passes. <u>The pool has advised us that due to Covid-19 no parent</u> <u>spectators are permitted to attend the carnival.</u>

All children should wear sports uniform and bring a towel, hat, sunscreen, food and plenty to drink in a resealable container. There will be **no school lunch orders** available. Children will **<u>NOT</u>** be permitted to go to the pool cafe during the day as it disrupts the carnival. Please ensure that all items of clothing/equipment are clearly labelled with their name.
