K-6 Pedlars' Parade & Bear Cottage & Stewart House Fundraiser – Thursday 10th November

Dear Parents,

Our Pedlars' Parade is a Manly West tradition where Year 6 students use their entrepreneurial skills to engage K-5 students in activities. They raise funds for a farewell gift to the school and selected charities. The SRC has nominated Bear Cottage and Stewart House as their charity and request that students bring a gold coin. The Year 6 also usually donate a Year 6 gift to the school, however this year any other money raised will contribute to the landscaping of the Yarning circle near the Aboriginal carving in the Year 6 area.

We ask that students in K-5 wear any of the colours of the Aboriginal flag (yellow, black, red) to have an understanding of the Yarning Circle and the landscaping that will occur in the school holidays.

The Pedlars' Parade will run from 9:40 to 12:40pm on Thursday 10th November. Students will visit the Year 6 stalls during allocated times throughout the morning. Year 6 students will set up stalls with a variety of activities and competitions for students to enjoy. NO home produced food will be sold at stalls. Activities and items will range from 20c to \$2.00 in cost. We ask students to bring their coins in a clearly labelled wallet, purse or zip lock bag.

As we cannot guarantee the content of food items (such as prizes of lollies and chocolates), students with allergies are encouraged to bring their own treats from home for that day. Students will need to wear a hat, sunscreen and suitable clothing i.e. clothes with sleeves that minimise sun exposure and covered shoers such as joggers. The canteen will also be open at recess and lunch.
