Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Your child has been selected to represent Manly West Primary School in the Manly Zone PSSA **Winter competition for 2022**. The competition will commence on Friday 13th May and run until Week 3 of Term 3 (5th August). However, there is no round on the final Friday of Term 2 (1st July). The cost for Winter PSSA will be **\$70**. The cost for this competition will be added to your Term account and be payable to the office. Please remember that this is an extra-curricular school activity and the payment includes all costs relating to PSSA Winter sport. Failure to pay could result in your child being removed from the team. If you have any questions or would like to arrange a payment method, please contact the school.

This year we have entered teams in Rugby League, Netball and both Boys and Girls Soccer. All children representing the school in Rugby League and Soccer will be required to sign and return a 'Jersey contract' (see over), before being provided with a jersey to look after for the length of the Winter PSSA Season. Junior Mixed Soccer, Netball and Nettas must wear full sport uniform. All sports must also wear a hat to and from the games. You must also sign a code of conduct (see over), which we would like you to discuss with your child before it is returned. The required sporting gear listed below must also be packed in your child's bag/kit. We require the permission note below, the Code of Conduct and Jersey Contract to be filled in and handed back to your child's coach(es) before Friday 13th May. Training will commence this week and continue through the season as follows: all Junior teams will train on a Thursday @8:30am. All Senior teams will train on a Friday @8:30am.

PSSA Code of Conduct



Your child has been selected to represent Manly West Public School in a PSSA competition for 2022. They are entitled to enjoy the privileges of representing their school as a team member at interschool sports organised by the Manly Zone PSSA committee, provided that they observe the following:

PSSA Code of Behaviour

- 1. Play for the fun of it and cooperate with team mates, opposition players, coaches and all officials without them you do not have a competition.
- 2. Make no criticisms of players, coaches or referees/umpires by word or gesture.
- 3. Be willing to train and prepare for the game each week. Preparation helps to prevent injury and increase the level of enjoyment in the team.
- 4. Encourage all members of the team
- 5. At all times, cooperate and follow the instructions your coach(es) provide, both on and off the field.
- 6. Remember the goals of the game are to have fun and improve your skills. Be modest in victory and generous in defeat.
- 7. Make sure you are upholding the Manly West expectations of Respect, Responsibility and Aspire at all times during PSSA training, travelling to and from games by bus, and at the sporting fields.
- 8. Your behaviour at school is also taken into consideration and must be deemed satisfactory in order to attend each week.
- 9. Each Friday, wear sports uniform, or team jersey, and pack the required equipment in your school bag ready to change into before boarding the bus (boots, shin guards, etc.).
- 10. Ensure that you look after all of your belongings when travelling to and from PSSA each Friday, and also be willing to help carry the team sporting kits and equipment to training and games.

The school may suspend or terminate these privileges if and when a serious breach of this Code of Conduct occurs, or if there is a recurrent breach of this Code of Conduct after a warning has been given. Following suspension from a team, entry to a PSSA team is subject to negotiation with the PSSA sports committee. In addition, it is understood that participation in PSSA sport is subject to payment of fees, and that refunds will not be given for suspension or absence from PSSA sport, as transport costs need to be met on a weekly basis. This agreement holds for the current school year and will be renegotiated in successive years.
