SCHOOL SWIMMING and WATER SAFETY PROGRAM

Dear Parents & Caregivers,

Thursday, 8th September 2022

During the first two weeks of Term 4 (Monday 10th – Friday 21st), Year Two students will be completing the School Swimming and Water Safety Program, held at Andrew Boy Charlton Swim Centre.

The Department of Education School Swimming and Water Safety Program is an intensive learn to swim program, which develops water confidence and provides students with basic skills in water safety and survival. The program is suitable for all levels of ability. The program is conducted over ten days. Each daily lesson is 45 minutes.

The program will continue **daily for two weeks** from Monday 10th October to Friday, 21st October, 2022. There will be no charge for instruction. **Pool entry** will cost \$6.60 per day. The **total cost** for the 10 day program is \$66 and will be included on the Semester Two account. Annual passes are able to be used – please let your child's classroom teacher know if you would like to use an annual pass for entry.

Times

All students will walk to and from the pool with their teacher.

2V & 2A are required to meet at their classroom **at 8.45am each day**. Their program will run from 9.30 - 10.15am. 2T & 2B are required to be at school as normal **at 9.20am each day**. Their program will run from 10.15am - 11am.

Students will need to bring the following:

- swimming costume
- goggles
- swimming cap (optional)
- rash vest or t-shirt
- school hat
- plastic bag for wet items
- water resistant sun screen
- school jumper for cooler day
- fruit break and water bottle

All items need to be packed in a small backpack or sports bag. Please ensure all items are clearly labelled with your child's name and class.
