## **Year One Newsletter**

Dear Parent/Caregiver,

Welcome back to Term 4. We hope you had a lovely holiday break and are looking forward to another busy and productive term. Please check the Term 4 diary dates as the students will be participating in many events in the coming weeks.

#### **MWPS Learning Walks in English and Mathematics**

Since last year, our school has been conducting regular Learning Walks in all K-6 classrooms. The Principal, Executive staff as well as many teachers have been visiting classrooms to gain an understanding of how students are articulating their learning as well as how they are progressing as Assessment Capable Learners. This has been a focus for a Collaborative Inquiry approach at Manly West PS. More recently, we have been sharing practices with other schools in our network.

This Collaborative Inquiry (CI) is based on research by Lyn Sharratt, where students use the Learning Intentions (LI) and Success Criteria (SC) to know and articulate what they are learning in the classroom as well as what they can do to improve their learning. Students receive more regular descriptive feedback from their teachers and peers and are managing self and peer assessment in order to begin to create authentic learning goals. From our data that we have been monitoring since last year, overall:

- Year 4-6 students are demonstrating strong knowledge of LISC when articulating their learning and their knowledge of how to improve.
- Years 2-3 students are demonstrating some knowledge of LISC when articulating their learning and their knowledge of how to improve.
- Years K-1 are establishing their knowledge of LISC and beginning to articulate their learning and their knowledge of how to improve.

#### English

Students will participate in speaking and listening activities, reading and comprehension tasks and a variety of writing lessons based on the new K-2 English Syllabus. Teachers will be monitoring students in all literacy aspects and developing activities that target progress in identified areas. Students will continue focused reading groups, developing and extending their decoding skills, fluency and vocabulary, as well as their comprehension skills. They will be utilising rich texts as a stimulus to produce their own informative, persuasive and imaginative texts. We will continue to program Spelling focusing on phonology, orthography and morphology.

### Mathematics

Students will participate in differentiated lessons which develop their skills in Number and Algebra, Measurement and Space, Statistics and Probability. Activities will be a variety of hands-on and written activities to achieve outcomes in the new K-2 Mathematics syllabus. We are focusing on building the capacity of students to reason, problem solve and explain their thinking mathematically.

#### Geography

#### **Science and Technology**

Mrs Menzies and Mrs Dowdle will teach the Science unit 'Schoolyard Safari'. Students will explore some common invertebrates found in the school environment. They will investigate the parts of the animals that enable them to move, feed and protect themselves.

Weekly computer lab sessions will focus on typing skills, navigating online programs and beginning to create texts using collaborative platforms such as Google Docs.
